We were approached by Windlab Developments in 2009 to conduct wind trials on our farm.

From the outset we found them extremely professional and comprehensive in their dealings with us. The processes of windfarm development were carefully explained, and a significant period of time was given for us to consider all aspects of their proposal. We never felt pressured at any time to make a decision, and all of our questions were answered quickly and completely.
